



During the 27th of September and the 1st of October 2021, the first meeting of the Erasmus + MEDIA TODAY – WATCHDOG OR SLUMDOG? project was held, its reference number being: 2020-1-PL01-KA229-081501_4. This meeting took place in Kemalpaşa, at Pakmaya Ülkü Hızal Anadolu Lisesi High School, Turkey.

The project focuses on the methods of avoiding manipulation by means of television and social media as well as on preparing students with a view to identifying the elements of manipulation from news, speeches, social media posts.
